You must be in school before the start of your first exam and remain in school until the end of your last exam.

Eg 1 On Friday 5th, if I study Technology and ICT but not Physics, I cannot go home after Technology but must stay and revise quietly in the Assembly Hall during session 2.

Eg 2 On Wednesday 13th, If I study Drama but not PE or Geography I do not need to come to school until 1pm.

Note: Language teachers will issue times for orals.

You must be in school at least 15 minutes before an oral.
